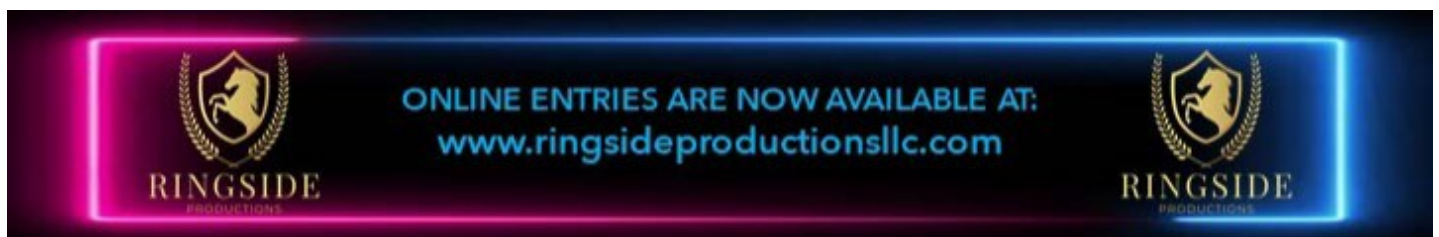

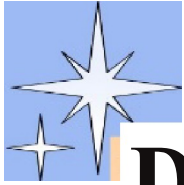

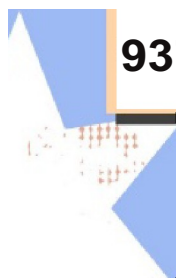

## Rules and Prohibited Items

### Motorized Vehicles on Property

- 1 You must have a valid driver's license to operate any motorized vehicle while on WEC property.
- 2 No motorized vehicles will be permitted to operate on SR 730.
- 3 Operating motorized vehicles on property in a reckless or unsafe manor is prohibited.

### Parking

1. Parking is prohibited in front of manure pits and/or anywhere signs prohibit.
2. Trailers are prohibited from blocking multiple parking spaces and must be parked in designated trailers parking locations.
3. Trailers are prohibited from parking and/or driving behind the RL Arena and barns E,F,G,H,I,J, or K.

### Camping and RV Sites

- 1 The dumping of grey and/or black water tanks onto WEC property is prohibited unless it is into a designated dump station.
- 2 Using WEC electricity without prior registration is prohibited.

## Dogs

- 1 Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times while on property.
- 2 Any dog that is deemed aggressive by WEC staff or security will be asked to be removed from property or put away in the owner's residence.

## Barns / Arenas

1. There is NO SMOKING inside any building on WEC property.
2. All medical waste (sharps) must be disposed of in the proper containers provided.
3. Any item brought into a barn that is deemed to be a fire hazard by WEC staff or security is prohibited.

- *Violation of any of the above may result in a fine and/or eviction from the property.*
- *These rules are not all inclusive.*
- *The World Equestrian Center is privately owned and we reserve the right to enforce these rules as needed.*

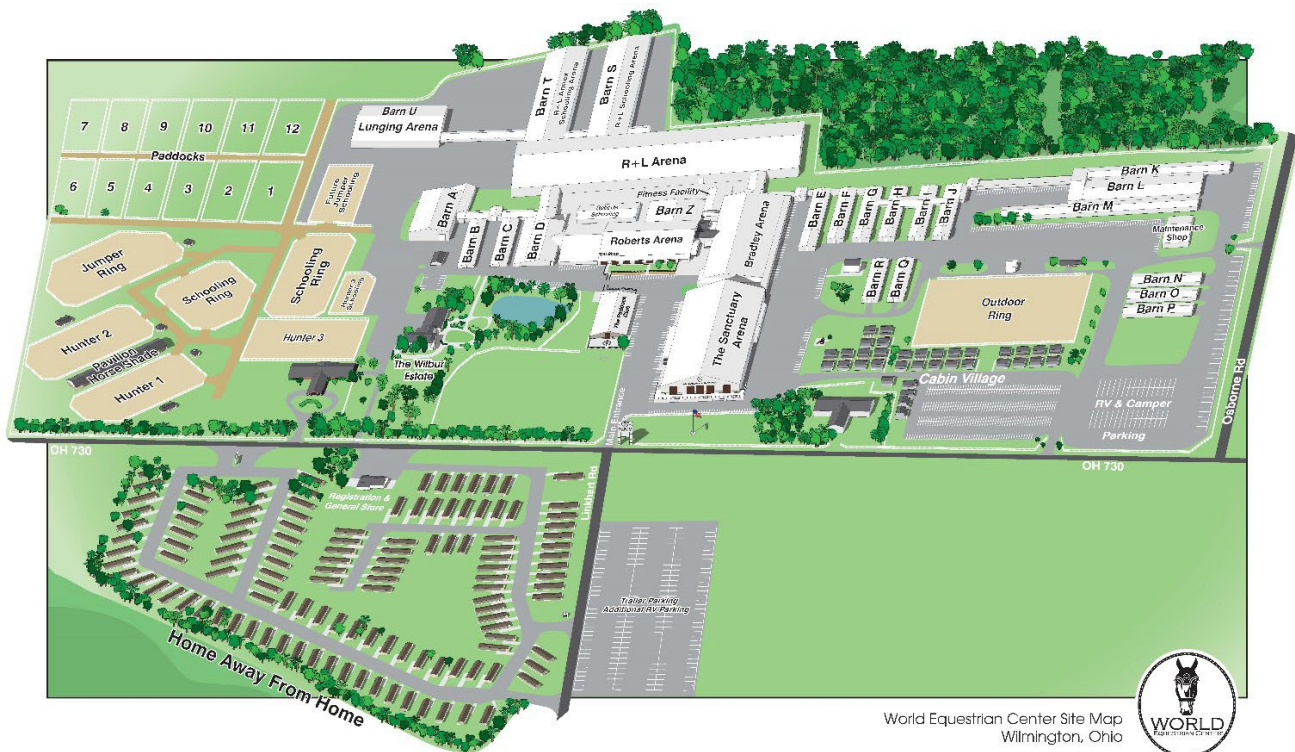

# SHOW GUIDELINES & REGULATIONS

1. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.
2. REGION XIV SILVERAMA WILL NOT ACCEPT ANY ENTRIES FROM INDIVIDUALS OWING INDEBTEDNESS TO REGION XIV OR ANY OF ITS MEMBER ASSOCIATIONS.
3. **AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT:** EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)
4. **ADMISSION TO RING:** No persons will be allowed in the ring except participants in class, judges, assistants, and the show photographers. Attendants will be allowed only after being called by the Judge or Ringmaster.
5. **AMATEUR STATUS:** Every person who has reached his/her 19th birthday as of December 1 of the previous calendar year and competes in classes for amateurs, under USEF rules, must possess current USEF membership and amateur certification issued by the Federation. This certification, which must be renewed annually, will expire on November 30 and must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the competition secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such certification provided by the Federation. Forms may be obtained from the Federation. Certification will be issued only on receipt of the application properly signed and is revocable at any time for cause. Amateur cards are not available for non-members.
6. **ARENA FOOTING:** All arenas have GGT mix footing. Sanctuary Arena 170' x 325', Roberts Arena 110' x 266', R&L Arena 130' x 615'.
7. **BEDDING:** SHAVINGS MUST BE ORDERED AHEAD OF TIME THRU THE SHOW. NO BEDDING WILL BE ALLOWED TO BE BROUGHT IN BY EXHIBITORS. Anyone found to violate this rule will be fined \$50.00 per stall. Shavings will be available at fair market price and must be purchased from the supplier on grounds. No animals may be stalled without bedding. Shavings may be ordered through Cindy Clinton prior to the show, all shavings will be put on your show bill and paid for in the show office. NO STRAW WILL BE PERMITTED TO BE USED ON THE GROUNDS.
8. **CAMPING:** The World Equestrian Center has 36 camping sites equipped with electric, water, and sewer and 60 with water and electricity for \$300 for a Full Hook-up or \$275 for a Partial Hook-up. You must reserve these on your entry form and stall/camping reservation form. Check in at the horse show office prior to parking your RV for your hang tag. First come first served. Reserve early.
9. **CALL FOR CLASSES:** The two-minute rule will be STRICTLY ENFORCED. All tack changes must be made in advance with the Paddock Announcer. YOU MUST CHECK IN WITH THE Paddock FOR EACH CLASS.
10. **CONCESSIONS:** Food will be available on the grounds.
11. **CONDUCT:** Exhibitors are hereby notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Judges/Officials on the part of the owner, trainer, rider or any other attendant, shall be grounds to disqualify the horse, and all entry fees and other charges and prize money won shall be forfeited.
12. **DOGS:** Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors.
13. **DRESS:** It is the tradition of the show ring that riders and drivers be correctly attired for the class in question, THAT ATTENDANTS BE NEATLY DRESSED, and horse properly presented. The Show Committee will bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

- 14. EARLY ARRIVAL/LATE DEPARTURE:** Stabling will be available after 10 a.m. on August 15<sup>th</sup>. ALL COMPETITORS MUST SHIP OUT BY 7 A.M. the day after the show is over or will be charged a \$50 layover per stall. THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED!

- 15. ENTRIES:** Pre-entries close July 17<sup>th</sup>. Entries postmarked after this date or entered at the show will be charged post entry fees. **THERE WILL BE AN ADDITIONAL \$25.00 CHARGE FOR EACH INCOMPLETE ENTRY**

**Entries will only be considered complete if the following are fulfilled when entering:**

- A. All Membership cards must be current. No need to send copies**
  - B. Registration Transfers must be complete. No need to send copies of Registration papers.**
  - C. Completed Entry form including signed Waivers.**
  - D. Check OR Credit Card # for Total Entry payable to Region 14 Championship Show.**
- NO BLANK CHECKS ACCEPTED!**

- 16. FEED & BEDDING:** Grain, hay and straw will be available at competitive prices.
- 17. HEADERS:** permitted in all driving classes but MUST be properly attired.
- 18. HEALTH PAPERS:** All out-of-state horses must have a negative Coggins test within twelve (12) months and a current (30 day) health certificate. GR 845 Equine Vaccination Rule 1. At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino pneumonitis) vaccination within six months prior to entering the stables.
- 19. JUDGES:** In the event due to illness or failure of a Judge to attend this show or perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge. No contact shall be made with the Judges before or during the period of the Show unless accompanied by a member of the Show Committee designated by the Committee for such purpose. Any offensive or abusive contact with the Judge by an Exhibitor will be cause for immediate removal from the show. Further, no exhibitor shall approach a Judge regarding a decision unless he first obtains permission from the Show committee or Steward, who shall arrange an appointment with the Judge. No exhibitor has the right to inspect the Judge's cards without the Judge's permission.
- 20. MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT**—Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- 21. P.A. SYSTEM:** Due to possible unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the P.A. System and class calls over that system are considered a courtesy. The exhibitor is responsible for having his horse at the gate at the prescribed time.
- 22. PADDOCK INSPECTION PROCEDURE:** At all Regional Shows horses will enter in an assigned order and be inspected for signs of abuse immediately prior to entrance into the ring for judging. Go shall be determined and posted by the birth date, oldest to youngest, for Breeding and In-Hand classes. This includes Post Entries. (Res. 20-97) The manner of inspection will be at the discretion of the show management. (Res. 93-94) (BOD 3/88) (BOD 5/95) Any horse that does not enter the ring in his assigned position may be eliminated at the discretion of the Show Management.
- 23. PARKING:** Specific areas have been set aside for parking of horse vans and trailers. Horse trailers and campers must be parked in designated areas.
- 24. PRIZE MONEY:** AHA Sweepstakes money will be mailed directly from AHA.



25. **PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR:** Any rider may wear protective headgear in any division or class without penalty from the judge. USEF strongly encourages all riders to wear protective headgear. It is the responsibility of the rider, parent, guardian, or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see that the headgear worn complies with safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition. Refer to current USEF Rule Book.
26. **PROTESTS:** may be made to the Show Committee by an exhibitor, owner, agent, trainer or the parent of a junior exhibitor for any violation of USEF rules. It must be in writing, signed by the protester, addressed to the secretary of the competition at which the alleged violation occurred, accompanied by a deposit of \$200 if member, \$300 for non-member (if check, payable to the competition) and received by the steward, technical delegate, a member of the Show Committee, the competition manager, or the competition secretary within 48 hours of the alleged violation.
27. **REFUNDS:** A refund on fees (minus the Office Fee) will be made upon request with a written statement from your veterinarian if received by July 17<sup>th</sup>. No Refunds After July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
28. **RESPONSIBILITY:** Region 14 will accept no responsibility for loss or destruction of property or equipment not owned by them or for damages to or by animals on exhibition at this show grounds or stabling areas. Show management will have the responsibility of enforcing all USEF and AHA rules. Region 14 recommends that all exhibitors become members of USEF. Members may receive a complete rulebook for reference when competing in shows. Special emphasis will be placed on rules pertaining to retention of natural action. Leg chains, rattlers, or other artificial appliances on a horse's leg while on the show grounds will be cause for immediate removal for the show and all winnings forfeited. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry. Intoxication, disrespect of the Judge and/or Show committee will be liable to disqualification for events and cancellation of awards without claims for damages. The committee reserves the right to make changes in procedure, personnel, rules and regulations as shall be deemed by them to be in the best interests of the Show.
29. **RETURNED CHECKS/CREDIT CARD DECLINE:** There will be a \$50.00 service charge for all returned checks or each credit card decline.
30. **SAFE SPORT STATEMENT:** Effective immediately, any competition with the start date of September 1, 2020 and later will be required to include the following Safe Sport statement in the Rules and Regulation section of the prize list: Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at [www.usef.org](http://www.usef.org).
31. **SHOWERS:** Available on the grounds next to Barn R.
32. **STALLS (HORSE & TACK):** Stalls are permanent stalls, 12'x 12' with doors. Those wishing to stable together must send their entries together. Tack stall availability — one tack stall for 1 horse up to and including 4 horses; two only from 5 and including 7 horses; three only for 8 and including 10 horses; four only for over 10 horses. There will be NO removal of doors or fronts for decoration. Stalls may not be painted, marred, or damaged in any way. The driving of nails, screws, staples, etc. is strictly forbidden. Exhibitors will be fined for any damage to stalls. ALL STALLS WILL BE RESERVED AS PAID FOR — NO STALL RESERVATIONS WITHOUT PAYMENT. All stall reservations MUST be made with the Show Secretary. No one may attach anything to buildings or barns with nails or screws. All show exhibitors wishing to hang curtains, etc. from their stalls must have a structure independent of the barns. You will be billed for all damages and repairs.
33. **USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT:** Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline, 2) exhibitions, 3) games and races, 4) classes for 4-H members, 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program), 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes, 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions, 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof in English, or current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division, and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

**DRESSAGE CLASSES MAY NOT RUN IN THE ORDER LISTED. When making entries in other sections please be aware of conflicting time schedules. The 2023 Dressage Tests will be used. Please notify Tony Reid (Dressage Coordinator [Tony@ringsideproductionsllc.com](mailto:Tony@ringsideproductionsllc.com) 314-719-6447) ASAP of possible schedule conflicts. Every effort will be made to adjust ride times IF POSSIBLE. Entries close July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2023. NO POST ENTRIES EXCEPT IN REGIONAL CLASSES. If post entering into Regional classes, Tony Reid MUST have a copy of your post entry 30 minutes after the last dressage class on Thursday. NO EXCEPTIONS! # *USDF Statement on Animal Welfare*

The United States Dressage Federation, Inc. (USDF), a federation of individual members and over 100 independent organizations throughout the United States, supports the concept of ethical treatment of animals.

Dressage is a classical method of training horses, based upon the horse's natural responses, as carried out in a gradual, planned program during which the horse's athletic abilities are improved in a systematic manner. As a result, the horse becomes capable, comfortable, and responsive in partnership with the rider without the use of force. Dressage competition at various levels of achievement is the ultimate test of the training program to determine whether the desired harmony between horse and rider has been achieved.

The rules pertaining to dressage competition prohibit the use of artificial appliances, training aids, and drugs, which would force the horse to submit. Instead, the emphasis is upon training and a cooperative partnership with the rider. Major competitions are carefully monitored to assure that there is no unnecessary force or harshness displayed.

Unlike other horse sports in which horses enter training at a relatively immature state, dressage training is usually not seriously begun until the horse is three or four. The top levels of achievement require five or more years of progressive training and it is not unusual to see horses in international competition in their late teens. This, in itself, places a premium on good care and soundness throughout the horse's life.

While supporting the concept of animal welfare in its broadest form, the United States Dressage Federation, Inc., also recognizes that it is unrealistic to ascribe human emotions and responses to the horse which in its wild state is a creature of flight, living a hard and precarious existence. Under domestication, the horse is assured of ample food, water, and shelter, as well as protection against infectious diseases and damaging parasites, thus leading a longer and healthier life with a high rate of survival.

As an educational organization, USDF has numerous programs, which teach people how to pursue the accepted, humane training methods. A program of certifying instructors also emphasizes protecting the horse's welfare in pursuit of dressage training.

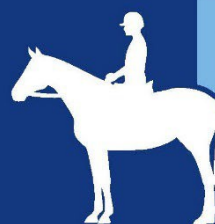

**Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions:** Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

#### Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

#### Memberships Defined

**Participating Membership (PM):** A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$90), 5-years (\$360), or life (\$1,800). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21<sup>st</sup> birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$72). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

**Group Membership (GM):** A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards Program and the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program.

**Business Membership (BM):** A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$240) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

**Non-Member (NM) Identification Number:** For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

**Horse Identification (HID) Number:** A one-time tracking number for horses (\$35). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded but will NOT be counted towards Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$80. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

**Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR):** A horse with an LHR (\$115) is eligible for Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

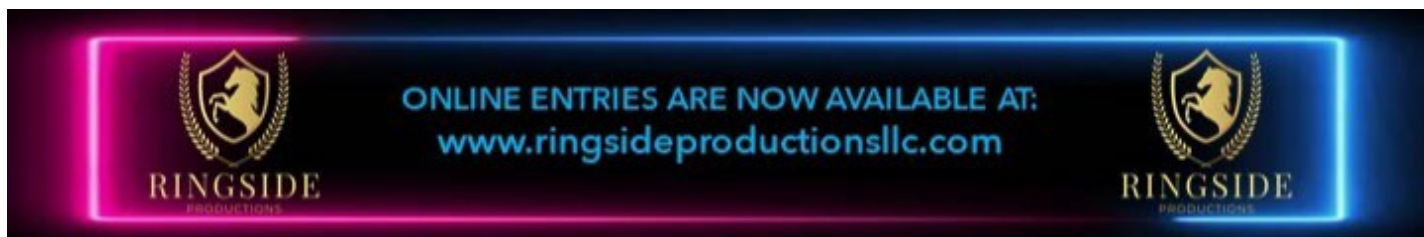

## AHA ENTRY AGREEMENT

I have read the rules concerning competitions as printed in the Arabian Horse Association (AHA) Handbook / Directory and Competition Prize List and agree to be bound by and subject to those Rules.

### AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION **This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.**

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

**I AGREE** that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

**I AGREE** as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way which implies endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

**By signing below** as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions, and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child.

This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible. I agree that exclusive jurisdiction and venue (place) for any legal action against AHA, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers or agents shall be in the local district courts or the federal court of the State of Colorado. If any part of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other parts shall remain effect.

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at [www.usef.org](http://www.usef.org), as amended from time to time.

B.
