

The Joe Hull Memorial Law Scholarship

In memory of Joe Hull and his service to the Arabian horse community.

The Joe Hull Memorial Law Scholarship honors Joe Hull, who served the Arabian horse community with extraordinary distinction in numerous leadership roles within the legal community as well as the Arabian horse community.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Students who are about to enroll **full-time/part-time** in their first year of law school and/or a current first or second year law school student
- Candidate must maintain their primary residence in AHA Region 14 (Ohio, Kentucky or West Virginia), or be a graduate of one of the high schools located within AHA Region 14
- Candidate must be a current member of AHA in good standing and through a Region 14 Member Organization (“Club”), regardless of age
- Demonstrate academic standing and achievement, participation in equine activities and extracurricular activities and general life experience will be considered.

Award Description

- Amount varies annually

Nomination Process

- Opens January 1 of each year, closes May 31 each year.

Selection and Announcement

- The AHA Region 14 Scholarship Committee selects winners in June or July each year from the completed nominations received.
- Announcement to be made on or before Region 14 Show in August

Other Requirements

- If Need Based: Must submit FASFA
- College Transcript required
- LSAT score required
- Essay: With focus on equine and community activities and how they will apply it through their law school career
- Same list of recommendations as the college scholarship
