### CHECK LIST

- Entry Form and Signatures must be signed on entry form and separate waiver by parent or guardian. Youth CANNOT sign entry form!

### Rules for being Eligible for these classes.

1. Horses cannot be in training. We do encourage retired show horses, or lesson horses, horses you do yourself from your home.
2. No trainers can ride horses.
3. Anyone can coach.
4. Riding suits are not permitted.
5. Proper attire, helmets, and boots are mandatory.
6. A neatly fitted shirt, and jod type pants or jeans.
7. Horses can be of any breed.
8. Horses will be asked to leave the ring if unruly.
9. Headers are allowed in the line up of the walk trot classes.
10. Mandatory Signatures of owner and or parents if minor.
11. Cannot cross enter between walk/trot and walk/trot/canter.
12. A cut back saddle, a hunt seat saddle, and or a western saddle are to be used.
13. Work bridles and bits, including snaffles, are allowed, and running martingales are encouraged.
14. Show grooming is permitted but not necessary, horses are not being judged.

### JUDGING

- All classes are to be judged on the ability of the rider to control and show their horse to its best advantage, and upon the riding skills of the rider.
- Each class should be judged on the rider's basic equitation and horsemanship skills suited to the class, with emphasis placed on the rider's ability to control the horse, identify correct diagonals, and leads promptly and control their horses rate in a consistent manner.
- Riders should convey the impression of good posture, balance and effective control while commanding proper speed and gaits and show ring placement.
