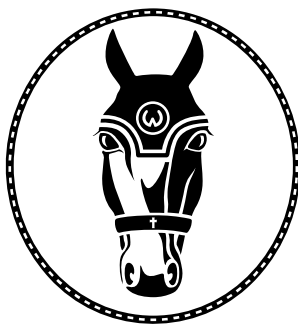

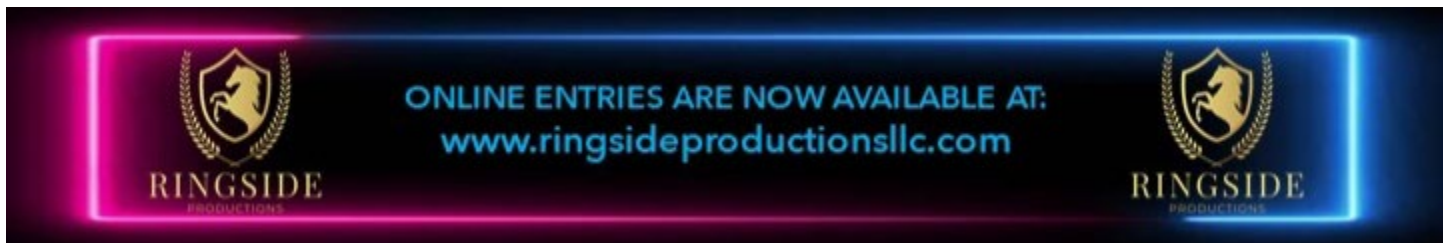

GENERAL INFORMATION

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

RULES: This Horse Show is conducted in accordance with the rules of USEF. **Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judges in accordance therewith.** Each participant in this show is responsible for the knowledge of and is subject to the USEF rules. Questions not covered by USEF rules shall be decided by the show committee and its decisions will be final.

Roberts: 110' x 266' Synthetic

R&L: 130' x 615' Synthetic

Sanctuary: 170' x 325' Synthetic

ADMISSION TO THE RING: No person will be allowed in the ring except participants in the class, judge, assistants and show photographer. Attendants will be allowed only after being called by the judge or ringmaster.

AHA MEMBERSHIP: All owners, trainers, riders, drivers, and handlers must have a "competition" level membership in order to compete at an AHA sanctioned show or pay a non-member single event membership (SEM) fee of \$35.00 **per show**.

ALCOHOL: It is unlawful for any person or organization to bring alcoholic beverages upon the premises. All alcohol must be purchased through the WEC bar located in the dining area.

ARRIVAL INFORMATION: Stabling is available at 10 a.m. the day before the show starts for the Spring Show. All horses must depart no later than 7 a.m. Monday. **Anyone wishing to arrive early must make arrangements with the show manager prior to arrival.** A \$30.00 per stall per day fee will be charged for early arrival (prior to 10 AM on Thursday) and or late departure (after 7 am). **Exhibitor intending on staying over Sunday night must advise the show manager.**

BAD CHECKS & CREDIT CARD: All checks and credit cards sent with entries will be cashed upon receipt. **Non-Negotiable check & credit card fees:** There will be a **\$100.00** charge for all returned checks and credit cards per occurrence. Parties who do not respond with full payment including \$100 fee within 7 days of being notified of such incident will be reported to AHA and USEF.

BEDDING: *SHAVINGS--you must order your shavings prior to Sunday before the show. Otherwise, you will have to wait until show office opens. No calls or changes after Sunday before the show. NO BEDDING WILL BE ALLOWED TO BE BROUGHT IN BY EXHIBITORS. Anyone found to violate this rule will be fined \$50.00 per stall. Shavings will be available at fair market price and must be purchased from the supplier on grounds. No animals may be stalled without bedding. Shavings may be ordered through Cindy Clinton prior to the show, all shavings will be put on your show bill and paid for in the show office. **NO STRAW WILL BE PERMITTED TO BE USED ON THE GROUNDS.**

CALL FOR CLASSES: When the start of any class requiring horses to be shown individually is delayed by horses not ready to perform the competition may be closed at the order of the judges or Show Committee, provided a warning is issued and exhibitors are given three minutes to appear at the in-gate ready to participate. In classes where horses compete collectively, a warning is issued, and the in-gate must be closed two minutes after the first horse enters the ring. Gate calls are complimentary, and it is the responsibility of the owner, rider, and trainer to check in with the paddock master located at the end gate.

CAMPERS: All campers parked on the show grounds must pay \$50 per day/\$225 per week to OHAHA. Call or text Cindy at 937-935-1753 and she will direct you to your spot. Camper parking passes may be obtained from the show secretary and must be purchased prior to parking. Camping passes must be always displayed on the camper in plain sight. All campers that are found not to have purchased a parking pass will be subject to a \$100.00 fine and towed at the owner's expense.

CANCELLATION OF CLASSES: The show manager reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes and prize money in any class with less than 4 entries.

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES: Supreme Halter Championships horses placing first in qualifying classes are eligible.

DOGS: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be kept on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead a dog while mounted. Dog owners who fail to comply with these rules may be subject to penalties under chapter 6 and 7 as well as issuance of a warning card.

DRESS: It is the tradition of the competition ring that riders and drivers be correctly attired for the class in question that attendants must be neatly dressed, and horses be properly presented. The show manager shall bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

OHAHA WILL NOT ACCEPT ENTRIES FROM INDIVIDUALS OWING INDEBTEDNESS TO ANY CLUB IN REGION 14, REGION 14 OR ANY ASSOCIATION FOR WHICH THIS SHOW OBTAINS APPROVAL TO HOLD SAID SHOW FROM.

ENTRIES: Entries must be submitted on an official Entry Form or may be done online.

Entries will only be considered complete if the following are fulfilled when entering:

- A. All Memberships must be current. No need to send copies.
- B. All Registration transfers must be complete. No need to send copies.
- C. Completed Entry Form including signed Waivers.
- D. Check or Credit Card for total entry written to OHAHA—NO BLANK CHECKS ACCEPTED!

****A \$25 Incomplete Entry Fee will be charged per entry if Memberships and Registration Transfers are not complete!!!**

FARRIER: There will be a Farrier on the show grounds. Darrell Mutschelknaus 330-204-4579.

MARSHALLS REGULATION: All aisles will be always open. There will be no closing off aisles for any reason. Decorations cannot exceed out more than 18 inches into the main aisles. **NO stall roof is allowed to be covered with any type of material. Don't forget smoke alarms and fire extinguishers. No household electric cords.**

HANDLERS: Cruelty to or the abuse of a horse by any person at a recognized competition is forbidden. Excessive use of a whip on any horse in a stall, runway, schooling area, competition ring or elsewhere on the competition grounds before or during a competition, by any person, constitutes a violation and renders the offender subject to penalty.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: Any rider may wear protective headgear in any division or class without penalty from the judge. USEF strongly encourages all riders to wear protective headgear. It is the responsibility of the rider, parent, guardian, or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see that the headgear worn complies with safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition. Refer to current USEF Rule Book.

HEADERS: Permitted in all driving and walk only and walk trot classes, but must be properly attired

JUDGES: In the event that due to illness or failure of a judge to attend the show or to perform their duties, the show committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for the one who is officially designated in the prize list, according to the USEF rules (GR 1213). No one shall approach a judge with regards to a decision unless he first obtains permission from the Show Committee, Steward or Technical Delegate who shall arrange an appointment with the judge at a proper time and place. No exhibitor has the right to inspect the judge's cards without the judge's permission.

JUNIOR EXHIBITORS: Junior Exhibitor's classes are limited to riders who have not yet reached their 19th birthday as of December 1, 2023.

LUNGING: Lunging is only permitted in certain areas. At no time is lunging in the show area permitted.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds.

Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

NATIONAL SHOW HORSES: All exhibitors must supply the show with a copy of the official NSHR Certificate of registration or confirmation letter before the horse is allowed to show. Pending registrations will not be accepted. In the event an unregistered horse enters into a NSH class, the show management will report the violation to USEF in accordance with applicable rules. Effective April 1, 2006 riders, drivers, handlers, trainers and at least one owner **MUST** be a member of the National Show Horse Registry in order to compete in National Show Horse classes at local shows or pay \$30.00 non-member fee.

PARKING INFORMATION: Specific areas have been set aside for parking of horse vans and trailers. All trailers must be parked away from the building; all violators will be ticketed and towed at owner's expense.

PROTESTS: Any exhibitor, agent, trainer or the parents of a junior exhibitor may make protests to the show manager for any violation of USEF rules. It must be in writing, signed by the protester, addressed to the secretary of the show at which the violation occurred accompanied by a deposit of \$200 (members) and \$300 (non-members) and received by the steward any member of the show committee, show manager, or show secretary within 48 hours of the alleged violation. According to the USEF rules (GR 603).

REFUNDS: Refunds can be requested prior to pre-entry deadline. After pre-entry closing date only class entry fees will be refunded with Certified Vets medical report verifying medical inability of the horse to show and a written refund request by the horses recorded owner, which must be delivered to the show manager by the end of the last class of the show.

RESPONSIBILITY: All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Ohio Half-Arabian Horse Association will not be held responsible for loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibitor or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the show committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the Ohio Half-Arabian Horse Association against any and all loss damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs; including attorney fees which may be incurred as a result thereof. Exhibitors, grooms, handlers, owners, etc. are hereby warned that they may not use any device or conduct which may cause harm to any other person(s), horse(s), or equipment. THE SUBMITTING OF ANY ENTRY FORM TO THE SECRETARY SHALL CONSTITUTE AN ACCEPTANCE BY EACH PERON SIGNING SAME OF THE PROVISIONS HEREIN SET FORTH.

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT: Effective immediately, any competition with the start date of September 1, 2020 and later will be required to include the following Safe Sport statement in the Rules and Regulation section of the prize list: Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

SHARPS CONTAINERS: Competition management shall place a minimum of one sharps container per each competition, whether or not stabling is provided, additionally, at least one sharps container per fifty occupied stalls for the disposal of needles and other sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses. It is the competition management's responsibility to replace such containers when full and dispose of them properly. Competition management may fine any individual including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposal instruments.

SMOKING: No person will be permitted to smoke in any building on the show grounds at any time as per Ohio State Law.

STABLING AVAILABILITY: No initial bedding furnished, All horses on the grounds must have a stall; the stall office is located beside the show office. No Stabling will be reserved without full payment. Stalls are available on a first come first service basis after prime sponsors are stalled. There will be no refund for stalls. **Health certificates within the past 30 days and a negative Coggins test are required for all out-of-state horses. Beginning December 1, 2015, all horses entering the grounds of a Federation- Licensed competition must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables.**

STALLIONS: May be shown by a woman or child in all classes except all Showmanship in-Hand, Walk Trot, Lead Line and Walk Only Classes.

STALLS/TACK STALLS: Stalls may not be painted, marred, or damaged in any way. The driving of nails, screws, staples, etc. is strictly forbidden. Exhibitors will be fined for any damage to stalls. The stalls are permanent, wood with wooden doors and metal bars on all stalls.

UNLOADING: After unloading all vehicles must be parked in a designated parking place for that particular vehicle as soon as unloading is completed.

USEF & AHA RULES: Show management will be charged with the responsibility of enforcing all USEF and AHA rules. Special emphasis will be placed on the rules pertaining to the retention of natural action: expressly hoof length, weighted shoes, pads or action brought about these similar artificial appliances. The use of chains, rollers or similar devices on the show grounds before or during a show is prohibited. The show manager will bar violators from further participation for the remainder of the show. Violators shall forfeit all entry fees and prize money for the entire show. National Show Horses may use these applications when applicable.

TO: ALL RIDERS, TRAINERS, OWNERS & GROOMS DATE: JANUARY 1, 2014

Upholding the welfare of the horses exhibited here is of primary concern to our management team. We require that all horses are treated with the kindness, respect and compassion they deserve, and they should never be subject to mistreatment. Owners, trainers, riders and grooms or their agents, must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of the horses owned and/or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose. We will provide for the continuous well-being of the horse by vigorously enforcing the rules of the USEF, which pertain to the welfare of the horse. Exhibitors are cautioned that article 302 which defines the USEF policy on abuse, Article 806 which pertains to poling, and article 320 which pertains to the use of whips, will be strictly enforced. No excessive use of whips or poling will be tolerated. Violators are subject under the above rules to elimination from competition and to protest or charge with resulting formal proceedings which may result in severe fines, suspensions, or other penalties. All incidents will be reported in the Steward's Report and reviewed by U.S. Equestrian's Executive Director/CEO for possible further investigation and charges for hearing before the U.S. Equestrian's National Hearing Committee.

HALTER JUDGING SYSTEM: COMPARATIVE

HALTER PROCEDURES: Halter class specifications: AR107 Conduct and Specifications.

The following procedures shall be followed in all Breeding classes, including Gelding in-hand classes:

A. Competition management has chosen the in the Ring Class Procedures.

B. In the Ring Class Procedure is as follows: Judging begins when the first horse enters the ring. From the moment the horse enters the ring its movement is being evaluated and scored. The horse shall enter at a trot and at the handler's discretion may either proceed directly along the rail or trot a counterclockwise circle at the in-gate end of the arena. Upon each horse reaching the designated position at the far end of the arena they are to remain relaxed. The judge(s) will then ask for the next horse to enter the ring. When all horses have entered the ring the horses shall be asked to walk collectively counterclockwise and or clockwise past each (and all) judge(s). They shall walk in a relaxed manner on a loose lead with the handler at the side of his/her horse, whips down. The lead line must maintain a discernible drape and the handler must not place his hand on the chain or close enough to in any way restrict the natural head and neck motion. The handler may not unnecessarily impede the forward motion of the horse while at the walk. Following the cessation of the walk all horses shall relax within the ring and only the horse "on deck" shall be prepared to show. Each horse shall be led to the judge(s) at the walk and presented to judging. In order to satisfy a proper presentation to the judge(s) horses should stand correctly, bearing weight on all four feet (not stretched), in a quiet and deliberate manner. Following the evaluation by the judge(s), horses shall walk away from the judge(s), and then strike a trot before turning left and proceeding counterclockwise down the rail. They shall resume their relaxed position at the end of the arena. The scores for all categories will be completed, recorded, and may be announced at this time.

C. Handlers are expected to keep a reasonable clearance between horse and judges should modify the alignment of horses to achieve that clearance. Further judging will not commence until the call judge approves the placement and spacing of all horses.

Ruling by the USEF Arabian Committee (May 2008): In all other multi-judge competitions and USEF/EC/AHA classes judged by a single judge—qualifying horses are judged comparatively for Supreme Championships.

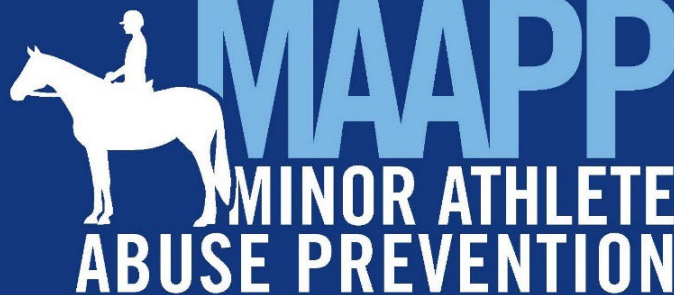

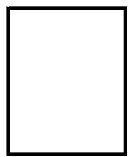

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows: I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and _____ ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree to be bound and abide by the rules, regulations, and policies of USEF as published in the USEF Rule Book and on the website at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves inherent risks and dangers. "Inherent risk of an equine activity" means a danger or condition that is an integral part of an equine activity, including, but not limited to, any of the following: (a) The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death, or loss to persons on or around the equine; (b) The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sounds, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals; (c) Hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions; (d) A collision with another equine, another animal, a person, or an object; (e) The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the participant or to other persons, including, but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant; (f) the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; (g) loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; (h) exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; (i) contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; (j) adverse weather conditions; (k) facilities issues and premises conditions; (l) failure of protective equipment (including helmets); (m) inadequate safety measures; (n) participants of varying skill levels; (o) situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and (p) other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").
